Dear Invitees,

In reference to the solicitation in subject, the IAEA has received a further request for clarification and responds as follows:

1. **Question**

“ ... We have a technical question about the scope of supply that we might have misunderstood. In our understanding the detailed electrical design of the motion control (cabinets design, wiring) and the PLC, GUI software programming are all not requested in the technical specification. Could you please confirm ... ”.

**Response**

This is correct. The contractor would draw up suitable specifications for control systems and make some recommendations for models. However, since cabinets will not be purchased within the lifetime of this contract, the detailed wiring layout is not required. A routing plan (i.e. suitable number of and position of ducts etc) for distributing the services (power, signal cables etc.) to the correct locations is required, as this interfaces with the shielding design. A schematic design of the logic of the safety PLC should be created, but the programming of a PLC is not required.

**To provide bidders with sufficient time to take into account the above explanations/clarifications, the IAEA is extending the deadline for submission of proposals until 9 June 2021, 17 :00 CET.**
